

Michael Turner's Waltz

Chord symbols: G, C, G, G, C, D, 1. G, 2. G, Am, D, G, Em, C, G, G, D, 1. G, 2. G

Michael Turner was a fiddler in Warnham, Sussex (1796 - 1885). It's unclear how this waltz came to carry his name (perhaps it was a favorite?), as the melody was written before he was born by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart in 1788, as the second of six German dances.
